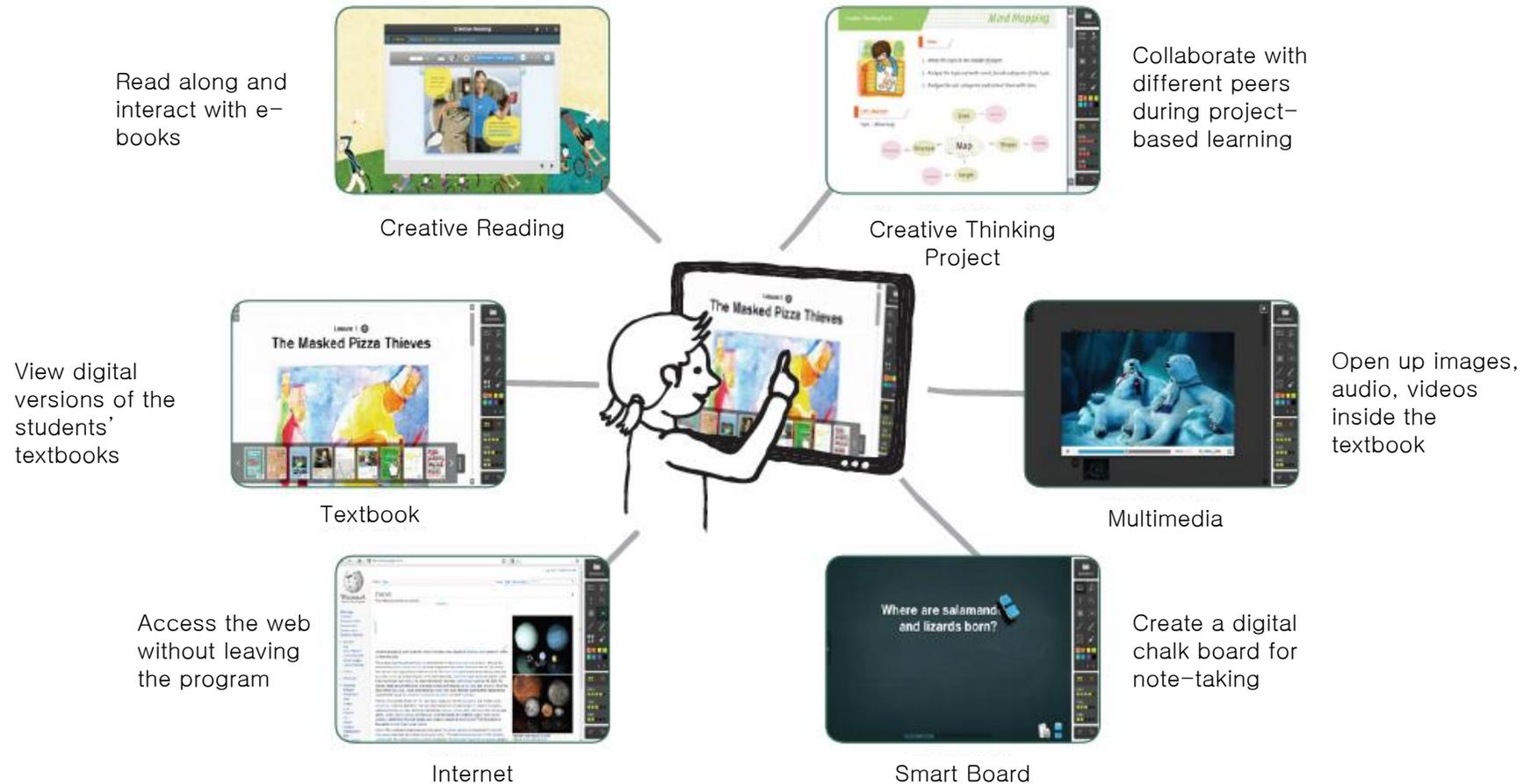

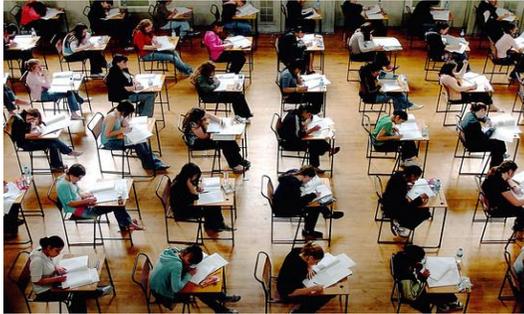

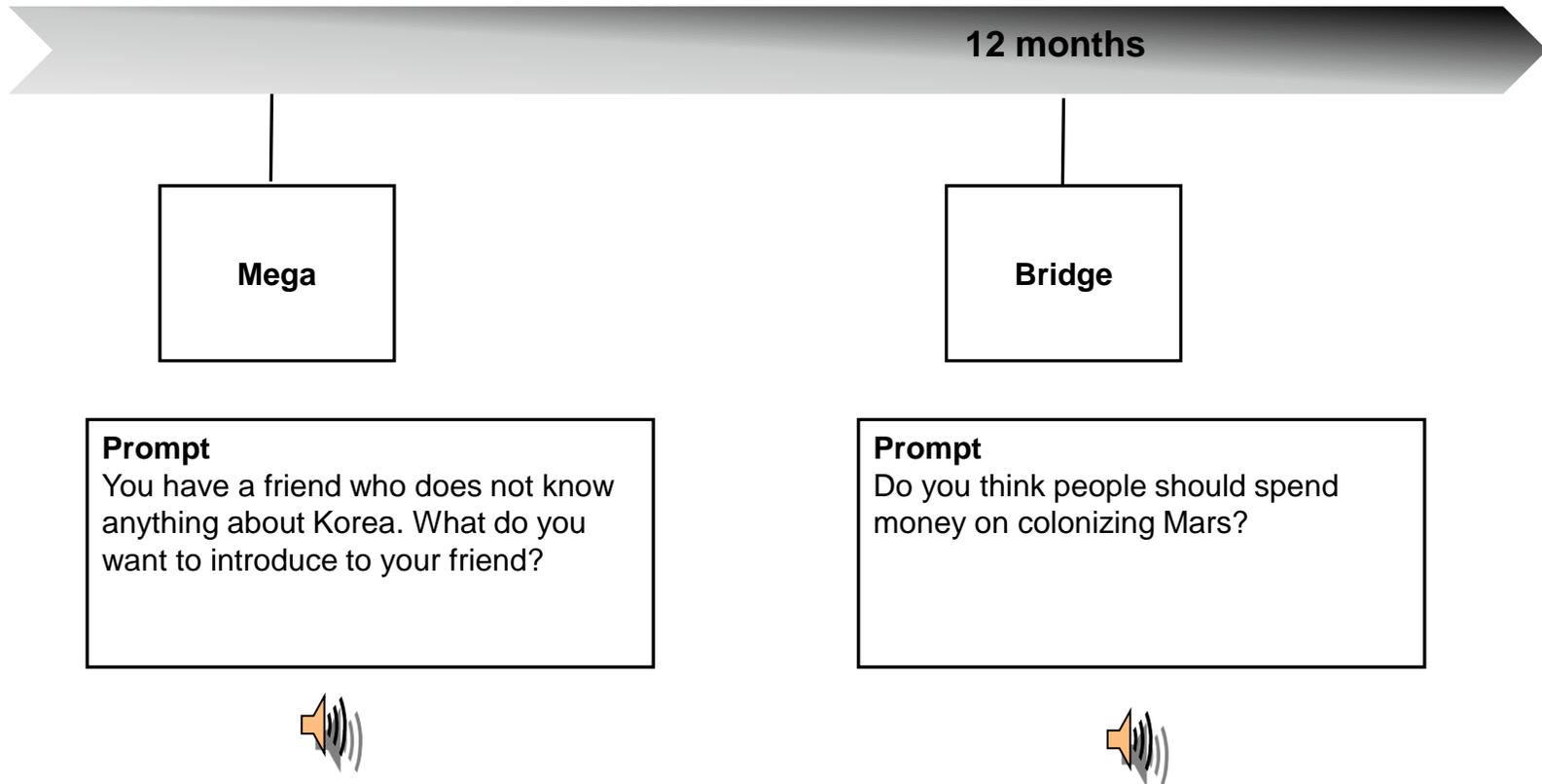

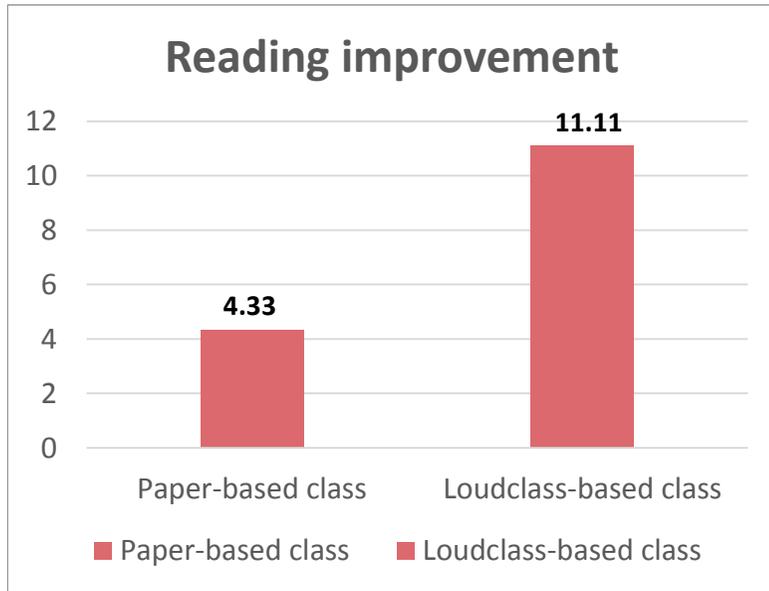
**First**, when I became adult, no more parent's help for my mistakes. So, I must have own responsibilities of my fault. Also I can't evasion of responsibilities anymore.

**Second**, I need to act carefully when there are young children. Adult needed to be a good models to young children. So, I can't act like a child and making an effort that children only seem my good side.

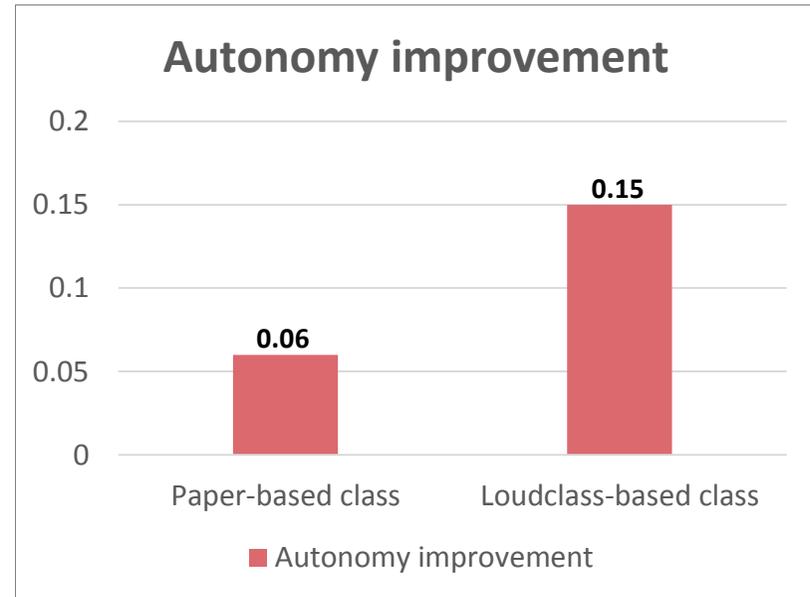
**In conclusion**, I think growing up means more responsibilities because there are no more parent's help for me and I needed to act carefully when I became adult.
